Aerial Lift Training Coquitlam - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This particular machinery provides access to otherwise inaccessible places for equipment or people. Also referred to as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the device is often used to access high areas. Maintenance and construction staff often need to utilize aerial work platforms on the job. They are utilized by firefighters for emergency access.

Designed for temporary application, aerial work platforms are different from elevators, which provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is intended to be operated by one individual, and is capable of lifting weights of less than one ton. Several kinds have load limits that are higher. There are a variety of types of aerial work platforms; like for example, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

Some aerial work platforms are available outfitted with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform could come together with special equipment.

Anybody needed to operate an aerial lifting machinery needs training, along with their supervisors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial machine work areas also must undergo training. Those training would learn aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise gain an understanding of the rules that apply to safely using these machines. Rules differ from province to province, and in worksites that are federally regulated.

Employees who are required to be lifted or work near an aerial lifting device has to be aware of all the possible dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown to be able to educate all of the workers who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is meant to train workers on safely utilizing boom-supported, self-propelled elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. Employees who complete the program will be given a certificate, signed by a qualified person to be able to verify successfully finishing a hands-on practical evaluation.
