Counterbalance Forklift Training Coquitlam - Counterbalance Forklift Training courses are always in high demand. The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift that is designed with a weight that counters the balance, equally distributing the load's weight across the forklift arms. Counterbalance forklifts are made so the weight on the lift is counterbalanced by the weight behind the centre of gravity. The load is projected out from the front of the equipment so it is visible to the forklift operator. This particular type of forklift truck should only be used on level, stable ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift operators are required to obtain training that would enable them to better understand the proper or right way across the arms of the forklift. The trainee will know to properly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees would learn the RTITB standards required for safely operating the forklift. Trainees would also become familiar with the types of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into areas that are cramped and small. This lift is very maneuverable and capable of accessing virtually whichever tight spot.

Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker is a different forklift that differs a little form the Walkie Pallet truck in terms of its lift height. This machine is designed to access tighter spaces and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. None of the Walkie line of lifts could be ridden. The driver has to walk behind them.

Rider Pallet Trucks

Rider Pallet Trucks are designed to be ridden. These riding lifts are perfect for dock unloading and loading.

Wave Work Assist Vehicle

The Wave Work Assist Vehicle is a counterbalance forklift intended to reach great heights of up to 17 feet.

Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks

Sit Down Counterbalanced Trucks include four-wheel and three-wheel forklift designs. These durable and tough trucks are made to be ridden.
