The responsibilities and daily tasks of a truck driver are probably going to be really different compared to those of an equipment operator who specializes in making use of demolition equipment on a construction site.

Jobs by equipment operators are normally broken down into 3 categories to be able to define the kinds of work for equipment operators. These 3 categories comprise crane operation, heavy equipment operation and truck driving. An equipment operator needs to have a license and complete heavy equipment operator classes. Once the necessary training is completed, an operator can operate these types of heavy equipment safely and effectively.

Heavy equipment operators have every day jobs to complete that depends on their requirements set by their bosses and likewise depends on the kind of equipment they are making use of. Like for instance, there are certain instances in which due to the parameters of a specific task, the operator will be required to work at night time instead of during typical day time hours. This could be common in road work situations or in a location that gets heavy day and evening traffic. One more example is a work routine of a truck driver could differ depending on whether he is transporting objects over hundreds, sometimes even thousands of miles, while shorter hauls may be carried out in a normal work day.
