Forklift Training Guidelines

It is essential that all workplaces using forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety regulations are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness which might lead to injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) The seat of the forklift is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift inspection and certification done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted properly on the forklift?
- 19) Have all forklift operators acquired certification?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) Are forklift operators up to date on training for all kinds of lift trucks being operated?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any equipment damage and forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the equipment being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
